### **Sharing Platforms**

### **Community Care Teams**

- I. The MCoC is going to be using Community Care Teams (CCTs) in the near future. It might be helpful to have the VA at the meetings, though this can be discussed in more detail closer to their inception.

- II. Easter Seals is currently working on two planning grants. Their ESG grant starts in July.
  - a. For RRH, there is no income threshold requirements.
  - b. For prevention services, the income threshold is 30%. This provides intensive case management and financial assistance in the form of a \$3,000 cap. Participants have to be ineligible for other federal programs.
- III. Liberty House now has 2 case managers, one for those who are currently enrolled and one for those who are transitioning out of the program.
