Coordinated Entry Update

The Family Place is expected to be open for Coordinated Entry for families in late summer/early fall.

Rich Doyle updated the group on the Homeless Resource Center in Manchester – A new collaboration will allow it to be open 5 days a week. Rich is committed to heading up Coordinated Entry for individuals.

We must clarify the plan for Youth Coordinated Entry.

It will be helpful to create a crosswalk of programs and eligibility criteria to facilitate the referral process. The CoC will need to create prioritization and referrals policies and procedures. Cathy will send out a doodle to set a date for a Coordinated Entry meeting with the CoC.

There was discussion about what to do about elderly people who have significant health needs. It is a gap in the system and will need to be better addressed through coordinated entry.

PIT Count Update

Mark updated the group that the preliminary numbers appear to have gone down this year. The Manchester numbers have been de-duplicated; however, they still need to be de-duplicated with the statewide data. The state will be taking the lead on deduplication of the data at the statewide level – BHHS is hoping to send the preliminary numbers to G&C by early April for final approval.

Each CoC has till the end of April to submit the PIT and HIC data to HUD.

APR Monitoring

Mark reported that the data committee will begin monitoring APR's again once HUD releases the new APR. If you have an APR due now, you should contact your HUD representative to clarify what you should do to submit.

Systems Focus

Cathy updated the group on the increased focus from HUD on outcomes that are systems-focused – It will be important that the data committee and the governance committee remember that outcomes of individual agencies are no longer as important as outcomes of the system in terms of the impact on funding.
