Dear MCoC member organizations,

After the MCoC general assembly meeting yesterday, the Leadership Committee met and came to a decision as to how to reallocate funds from existing projects to complete the 5% of our Annual Renewal Demand that HUD is requiring us to place in a second tier, making it most susceptible to cuts based on HUD's budget.

As a result, an additional \$27,621 is available for reallocation into either: 1) a Permanent Supportive Housing program designed to serve 100% chronically homeless persons; or 2) a Rapid Re-Housing program designed to serve 100% homeless families.

The Leadership Committee also voted to place both this project and the reallocation of Southern New Hampshire Services' SSO project into Tier 2 to greatly reduce the possibility that HUD would cut existing programs.

These funds require a 25% cash or in-kind match. Eligible applicants are nonprofit organizations, local governments, instrumentalities of state/local governments, and public housing agencies.

If you are interested in applying for these funds, please send me an email by 5pm on Monday, December 30th with the following information:

- 1) Agency Name
- 2) Contact Person (name, email, phone #, etc.)
- 3) A statement indicating your intent to apply – something simple like "Families in Transition intends to apply for these MCoC reallocation funds"

All applications will be due in e-snaps (<https://esnaps.hud.gov/>) on Friday, January 3rd at 5pm. If you have never used e-snaps, a guide to setting up a "Project Applicant Profile" and also "Accessing the Project Application" are attached for your reference.
