Dear MCoC member organizations,

Due to a change in HUD funding priorities, Southern New Hampshire Services has chosen not to submit a renewal application for their Supportive Service Only program. As a result, \$36,547 is available for reallocation into either: 1) a Permanent Supportive Housing program designed to serve 100% chronically homeless persons; or 2) a Rapid Re-Housing program designed to serve 100% homeless families.

These funds require a 25% cash or in-kind match. Eligible applicants are nonprofit organization, local governments, instrumentalities of state/local governments, and public housing agencies.

If you are interested in applying for these funds, please send me an email by 5pm this Friday with the following information:

- 1) Agency Name
- 2) Contact Person (name, email, phone #, etc.)
- 3) A statement indicating your intent to apply – something simple like “Families in Transition intends to apply for these MCoC reallocation funds”

All applications will be due in e-snaps (<https://esnaps.hud.gov/>) on Friday, January 3rd. If you have never used e-snaps, a guide to setting up a "Project Applicant Profile" and also "Accessing the Project Application" are attached for your reference.
