

## **Timeline of FY2013-FY2014 CoC Program Competition Project Scoring and Ranking Process**

**9/12/2013** – Scoring tool was first presented to MCoC Leadership Committee

Leadership Committee voted to approve this tool. [Minutes of this meeting were posted on the MCoC website within seven days of this meeting](#)

**9/19/2013** – Scoring tool was presented to MCoC Data Collection Committee

Data Collection approved this tool as well. It will be presented to all CoC funded agencies for final approval. [Minutes of this meeting were posted on the MCoC website within seven days of this meeting.](#)

**9/20/2013** – An electronic copy of the scoring tool and all related documents were distributed electronically to all MCoC funded agencies who were asked to submit a final vote whether or not to officially adopt this method

**10/23/2013** – All funded agencies have submitted “yes” votes to approve this scoring tool

**11/22/2013** – FY2013-FY2014 CoC Program Competition NOFA was released and the Collaborative Applicant notified the MCoC

**12/11/2013** –MCoC was notified of possibility to apply for CoC Program funds under 2013-2014 CoC Program Completion

**12/13/2013** – SNHS notified Collaborative Applicant that they will not be reapplying for their \$36,547 in CoC renewal funds

**12/13/2013** – CoC funded agencies were notified of all MCoC project scores

**12/17/2013** – Collaborative Applicant notified entire MCoC that \$36,547 in reallocation funds forfeited by SNHS is available for application

**12/19/2013** – MCoC Leadership Committee met with MCoC funded agencies to discuss project scores and ranks to inform Leadership Committee’s Tiering decisions

**12/19/2013** – MCoC Leadership Committee met to decide how to reallocate program funds and place a total of \$64,168 into Tier 2

The \$36,547 for which SNHS will not apply will be placed into Tier 2, leaving another \$27,621 to be reallocated and placed in Tier 2

These funds will be reallocated from among the three lowest scoring projects

**12/20/2013** – A revised copy of the [FY2013-FY2014 CoC Program Competition NOFA](#) was posted on the MCoC website

**12/20/2013** – Based on the 12/19/13 recommendation from the Leadership Committee, the MCoC Chair asked three low-scoring projects to reduce their renewal amounts. All three projects agreed to do so

**12/20/2013** – Collaborative Applicant notified entire MCoC of an additional \$27,621 in reallocated funds is available for application by either PSH projects for CH or RRH for families

These reallocated funds will be placed into Tier 2 and applications ranked by Peer Review Committee

**12/30/2013** – Due to a reduction in the MCoC's ARD, the Collaborative Applicant reduced the amount necessary to be placed into Tier 2

Funded agencies and Leadership Committee were notified of a proposal to divide it proportionately among the projects from which funds were reallocated

**12/30/2013** – MCoC Leadership Committee members and funded agencies agreed to this change

**12/30/2013** – Collaborative Applicant notified MCoC of adjusted reallocation grant amounts

**1/2/2014** – All project application E2s submitted in eSnaps (over 30 days before final submission deadline)

**1/9/2014** – Peer review Committee met with MCoC funded agencies to rank projects, including new grant applications in Tier 2

**1/14/2014** – MCoC funded agencies were notified of Peer Review Committee's ranking on projects in Tier 2

**1/14/2014** – Funded agencies were notified as to which new project applications were accepted and which were rejected

**1/16/2014** – MCoC funded agencies were notified of final project ranking for both Tier 1 and Tier 2

**1/16/2014** – Collaborative applicant notified all funded agencies that all renewal project applications had been accepted and submitted in Tier 1
